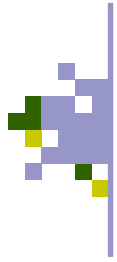

Stay Safe is a program of the Crime Prevention Association of



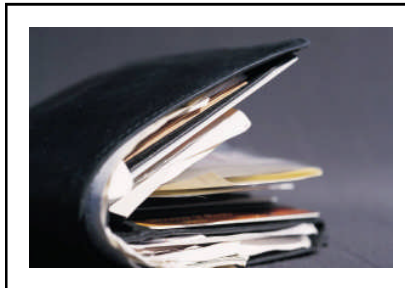
Toronto 'CPAT' (formerly Crime Concern) that teaches adults how to reduce the risk of victimization while on the street. It is an interesting and interactive safety presentation offered free to groups or organizations at their location.



The Stay Safe program will teach you:



- What to carry and what not to carry in your purse/wallet.
- The best way to carry cash, keys, debit & credit cards, I.D
- Ways to reduce your risk of becoming a victim of crime.
- How to prevent assault and injury.
- What to do when approached by a suspicious person.



When you go out, Remember these Rules:

1. Carry very little cash.
2. Take only one or two credit cards.
3. Carry your health insurance card.
4. Use a debit card cautiously.
5. Do NOT carry your Social Insurance Card, Birth Certificate or Passport unless you need them for a specific reason today.
6. Instead of a purse, use a pocket or waist pack.
7. Be alert, aware and walk confidently.
8. Never fight for your wallet.
9. Do not count money in public.
