The newly formed Board of Directors of the Ontario Community Watch Association 'OCWA' have met four times since its formation in September, 2005. The accomplishments to date are as follows:

Incorporation—as of February 2006, the incorporation was complete.

Logo—the logo has been designed and is now as shown at top right of our newsletter.

Website—in final stages and expected to be launched in May 2006.

Funding—National Crime Prevention Strategy grant application for phase 1 was successful and we have now applied for funding for phase 2.

Application for Ontario Trillium Foundation grant will also be submitted.

There is no doubt that the progress that has been made is a giant step from where we were three years ago when the formation was initiated. The members of the Adhoc committee, which consisted of members from London, Toronto and OPP representation worked together to apply for the first grant and developing the foundation of the Association.
